


December, oh yeah there was snow.








## April

So the children all gather to help the shepherd and his dogs, they can run around with the animals and have a ball.


# Canal rides, St. Peter's and so much walking






The food is fantastic, barbequed squid and fresh fish everyday, the boys are healthy and thriving and, of course full of play.




It's March and time for Carnival, we had face painting and a dance/parade of children through the streets.

## Venice








Brig's Birthday present was a trip to Venice. Ah pizza!
